Who: Any student(s) 4th-12th grade

Why: Great experience to sing for a judge and get positive feedback

What: Songs in any of the following styles:
classical, barbershop,
art songs, and Broadway

Outcome: Medals for superior, pins for excellent, certificates for all

How Much: Only \$5 per student, per entry

Students may sing as a soloist and/or as part of a small or large ensemble.

(Small Ensemble = 2-9 singers, Large Ensemble = 10-20 singers)

How to use this in your curriculum:

- ✓ For your younger singers, this can be a great opportunity to perform for your budding soloists who do not get many chances to sing alone.
- ✓ For your smaller ensembles or specialty groups that can't go to Choral Festival, this is a chance to sing in an adjudicated situation and get positive feedback

for your singers (large ensembles get trophies for superior or excellent placement!).

- ✓ For your aspiring music majors, this is a fantastic practice run for college auditions or Governor's School auditions.
- ✓ For anyone in your school who needs a little bit of encouragement or a push in the singing direction, this can be a great way to get them started.
- ✓ For those students who just can't get enough...give them another opportunity!
