Dear MTVA Directors of All State Choir Students,

I know that you are all busy preparing for holiday performances. However, I felt it necessary to communicate with you regarding music and CD's, as well as student rankings.

All music for All-State and All-State Alternates has already been sent to individual schools. If you did not receive your music from JW Pepper, you should contact them to order any missing music and have it shipped directly to your school. Pepper already has the TMEA lists for All State 2010. All you will need to do is tell them which choir your student is in and you will pay MTVA for MUSIC at 2<sup>nd</sup> TIER AUDITIONS, and MTVA will in turn pay JW PEPPER. YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY J.W. PEPPER. Our contact person at Pepper is Jeff Whitsett. If you should need more music, email him at [jwhitsett@jwpepper.com](mailto:jwhitsett@jwpepper.com) for the fastest response.

As for CD's, Mark Robertshaw did not send enough CD's in the first set for the lower portion of alternates. Therefore, the CD's that were mailed out were intended for only those students who were ranked as All State or the highest portion of All State Alternates. I am working with Mr. Robertshaw to get your remaining CD's, along with instructor CD's, in your hands by the end of this week. I will let you know as soon as I receive verification.

I know that some of you have also inquired about finding out rankings for your students. The ranked spreadsheet, as I have been told, is saved on the MTVA computer that has been broken and is being repaired. I am working today on acquiring that list for you.

Please know that I have sent every CD that I was sent to you. As soon as I receive the remaining CD's, they will be sent out directly to you. My goal is to get them to each school before the break.
